One of the most important dates in Black history in Britain, is March 2, 1981. Twenty-five thousand Afrikans took to the streets of London in response to the New Cross Massacre. A suspected racist fire-bomb attack had killed 13 Black youths, and injured 27.

We gathered to protest the woeful police investigation, racist reporting, ongoing racial attacks, and more. We demonstrated the power of our unity, in a turbulent decade that changed the political landscape forever...

## National Black People's Day Of Action

On March 2, 1981, the **Black People's Day** of Action demonstrated the power of Black unity, beginning the process of breaking down racialised barriers. Yet, 31 years on, many of us, particularly the youth, know nothing about this history.

Today, we continue to endure the same injustices and more, including; racial attacks, disproportionate school exclusions and underachievement, Stop & search and deaths in police custody, DNA profiling etc. Drugs, guns, and gang violence kill up to thirty young people every year and wrecks the lives of many more. Thirty years on, we seem to have lost the spirit of resistance and our sense of community.

At last year's commemoration a motion was passed to make March 2nd, a national public holiday, which will be primarily youth focussed, will link the New Cross atrocity and the State's lack of a response to the threats facing our young people today. The emphasis will be on building a National Afrikan People's Parliament for our empowerment and as the mechanism for implementing the solutions to the grave injustices we continue to suffer.
